Problem

- The Department of Homeland Security, found White Supremacist Extremism to be the #1 domestic terrorism threat in the US.
- Pew Research reveals that 11 am is still the most segregated hour in the Church.
 Approximately 83% of US churches are homogenous.
- According to Barna, 59% of White Christians and 39% of Black Christians believe racism is a problem of the past.
- Additionally, Barna shares that 94% of Christians (of all races) believe the church plays a crucial role in the work of reconciliation.

2016

 OneRace was established by several Pastors, across Metro Atlanta.

2017

- Obtained 501c3 & Tax ID
- Hosted first Pastor Cohort

2018

- Hosted 21 pastor groups and 40 public prayer gatherings.
- Assembled 25,000 people for OneRace Stone
 Mountain.

2019

- Convened 1,000 leaders for The 400 Conference.
- Gathered 100,000 people in 121 live events for the Day of Remembrance.

2022


- Released the book, Know Own Change; 7-day YouVersion devotional series; and the Reconciler Small Group Experience.
- Facilitated the Southern Justice Experience with over 100 pastors and leaders.

2021

- Gathered 3,000 believers for the Jesus & Justice event.
- Donated \$60,000 to six Mercy & Justice partners.

2020

- Assembled over 13,000 people for the March on Atlanta.
- Discipled 500 believers through the Reconciler Pathway.



Current Needs

- Host the Southern Justice Experience for 100
 pastors and leaders across the country. The total
 cost is \$50,000, equipping 100 leaders. \$500 to
 impact each leader.
- Mobilize the church to host 1,000 Reconciler Small Groups mobilizing 10,000 believers across America. The project cost \$250,000, with each group costing \$250
- Launch National OneRace Pastor Groups, to empower 100 leaders - \$20k to launch 1 group. \$2k to reach a single pastor. Total cost \$200,000
- Director of Operations and Development Coordinator Adding a staff person at a \$70k salary will help us to raise an additional \$300k annually, reaching 3 more cities.
- Fall 2023 Catalytic Gathering The cost of gathering is \$200,000 to reach and mobilize 5,000 believers in OneRace Reconciler Groups.
